Greetings!

On 17th, 18th and 19th November 2020, our students of Grades 6 to 8 will be holding the second edition of Student-Led Conferences (SLC) for this academic year.

Student Led Conference is a conference with Parents and Teachers led by the Students. In this program, the students will reflect upon their learning and speak about his/her progress in achieving the learning outcomes and discuss their areas of improvement. The teachers will act as facilitators and guide them through the conference.

On the above-mentioned days students will be having **learning space and asynchronous learning** (off-screen time) where teachers will be uploading all necessary assignments and flipped resources for students to complete through the day.

We believe that Student Led Conferences will provide an opportunity for your ward to reflect upon their successes up to midterm examination and to provide you with examples of what they have learned in each of the academic areas. We emphasize that these are Student-Led Conferences and while a teacher will be present, he/she is acting as mediator, to encourage open communication on student achievement. We view this as an extremely positive opportunity for our students to emphasize their strengths, acknowledge areas that need improvement, and to share goals he/she wishes to reach by the mid-term of the academic year.

We strongly encourage you to be an active part of this conferencing process. **We will hold conferences from 7.50 am to 4.00 pm through Microsoft TEAMS as per the time slot allotted to you. The class teacher will be sharing your ward's individual time slot with each subject teacher.**

As parents and guardians, you are critical partners in helping support your child's learning and growth. **Attendance for the same is mandatory.**
