Effectiveness of Student-Led Conferences

- *Students take responsibility for reporting their learning to parents.*
- *Students organize their work and prepare to share what they have learned with parents.*
- *The student-led conference process increases parent involvement and participation in schools.*
- *Students engage in self-reflection of the learning process.*
- *Develops student’s self-evaluation and presentation skills.*

On 22nd, 23rd and 24th November 2020, our students of Grades 1 to 5 will be holding the second edition of Student-Led Conferences (SLC) for this academic year.

Student Led Conference is a conference with Parents and Teachers led by the Students. In this program, the students share their portfolio of work, reflect upon their learning and speak about his/her progress in achieving the learning outcomes and discuss their areas of improvement. The teachers will act as facilitators and guide them through the conference.

Students will have **learning space and asynchronous learning (off-screen time)** where teachers will be uploading all necessary assignments and flipped resources for students to complete through the day.

We believe that Student Led Conferences will provide an opportunity for your ward to reflect upon their successes up to midterm examination and to provide you with examples of what they have learned in each of the academic areas. We view this as an extremely positive opportunity for our students to emphasize their strengths, acknowledge areas that need improvement, and to share goals he/she wishes to reach by the mid-term of the academic year.

We strongly encourage you to be an active part of this conferencing process. We will hold conferences from **7.50 am to 4.00 pm** through Microsoft TEAMS as per the time slot allotted to you. The class teacher will be sharing your ward's individual time slot with each subject teacher.

As parents and guardians, you are critical partners in helping support your child's learning and growth. **Attendance for the same is mandatory.**

Note: Parents who desire to have a longer discussion on any concerns or issues may make prior appointments with teachers or meet them later. We request you to kindly adhere to the timings given as per the roll numbers.
