Dear Parents,

I am glad to inform you that Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India has launched a scheme called “**Scholarship Programme for Diaspora Children**” (SPDC), for the academic year 2019-20 on May 31, 2019 for the children of NRIs/PIOs belonging to 68 countries pursuing under graduate courses in several disciplines in India. Only fresh year students (1st year) with the age group of 17 to 21 years as on 31.10.2019 and who have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination with minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grades of all subjects in the qualifying examination shall be eligible to get the scholarship.

SPDC aims at providing financial assistance to the needy children of some specific categories to assist them in pursuing specific professional and non professional (except medical and related courses) undergraduate courses in Indian Universities / institutes. SPDC program is awarded to four categories a) Children of Persons of Indian Origin / Overseas Citizens of India b) Children of Non- Resident Indians c) Children of Indian Workers in ECR countries studying outside India d) Children of Indian Workers in ECR countries studying in India.

Under the scheme, the Government of India provides partial financial assistance to the extent of 75% of the total Institutional Economic Cost (IEC) subject to a maximum of US \$ 4000 per annum. IEC includes tuition fees, hostel fees and other institutional charges (excluding food charges). The total income of the parent (s) of the candidate should not exceed an amount equivalent to US\$ 4000.
