BYOD Policy

- ⇒ Students will access own account and make sure no one else has your account user name and password. Take onus for your account privacy.
- \Rightarrow Students are responsible for all actions that take place on one's user account.
- ⇒ Students to be responsible users while they download, transfer, write, draw or view any graphic text. Students should display high moral value skills avoid use of sites inappropriate to their age. Students to take responsibility to inform the teacher should any one accidentally access anything age inappropriate.
- ⇒ Students to avoid download, transfer, install or use any applications, utilities, games, music, video files or other files or software not approved by the School.
- ⇒ Students to visit sites on the acceptable website list unless otherwise directed by their teacher.
- ⇒ YouTube, gaming sites, and social networking sites are expressly forbidden unless authorized.
- ⇒ Students strictly forbidden to partake in any type of cyberbullying. Be sensitive to each other and respect the rule of the land. Any untoward observed be reported and action will be taken.
- ⇒ Students will treat the School computers, systems and the school network with respect and care.
- \Rightarrow If any student is observed to misuse action will be taken.
- ⇒ Students will only access the local server or wider network that is shared to students / staff.
- ⇒ If any student uses a material from the Internet for their own work, they will clearly state the source.
- ⇒ During class hours, students will only use e-mail, chat or messaging facilities if required / advised.

- ⇒ Students will only use their school e-mail address responsibly and appropriately during school hours.
- \Rightarrow Students to avoid eat or drink while inside the ICT lab.
- ⇒ Students will not attempt by any means to circumvent the restrictions placed upon the machine or the network they are connected to.
- ⇒ Students are not permitted to "jailbreak" the school Mobile device or attempt any repairs.
 Students must understand the school Mobile device remains the property of the School.
- ⇒ Students will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the school Mobile devices. Students will not deface the serial number Mobile device sticker on any Mobile device.
- \Rightarrow Students will take good care of their OWN device.
- \Rightarrow Students will never leave the BYOD device unattended.
- \Rightarrow Students will never loan out their BYOD device to other individuals.
- ⇒ Students will keep food and beverages away from the BYOD device since they may cause damage to the device.
- ⇒ Students will use the BYOD device in ways that are appropriate, meeting School expectations.
- ⇒ Students understand that the BYOD device is subject to inspection at any time without notice.
- ⇒ Students will ensure that anti-virus and anti-malware software is installed on their BYOD and is kept updated regularly and frequently.
- ⇒ Students understand that their personal device is their responsibility and School is not responsible for any breakages, lost, theft or any damage caused by malware on the network.
- ⇒ Students will follow the policies outlined in the JSS Private School BYOD/Acceptable Use Policy.
