

Shreeya Shivram won a **silver medal** in the 50m butterfly **First Ceylon Swimming Championship**.


Tritiya Prajeesh won **5 gold medals** in Emirates Cup series Championship organized by the **UAE Swimming Federation**.

His exceptional performance highlighted his dedication and skill.






From Classroom to Greatness: A glimpse of our Teacher's Achievements
