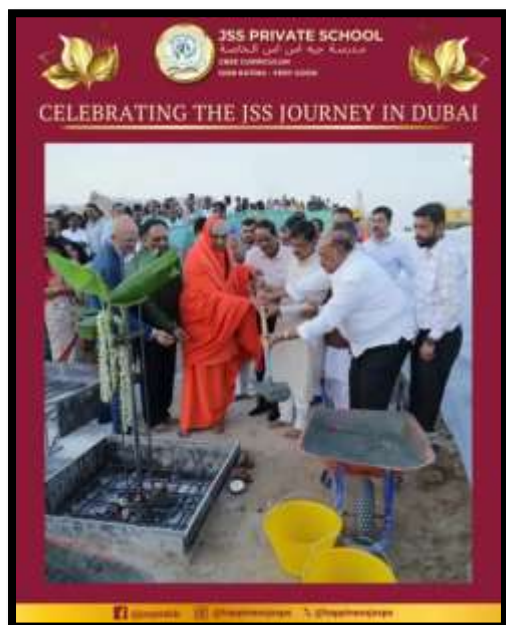

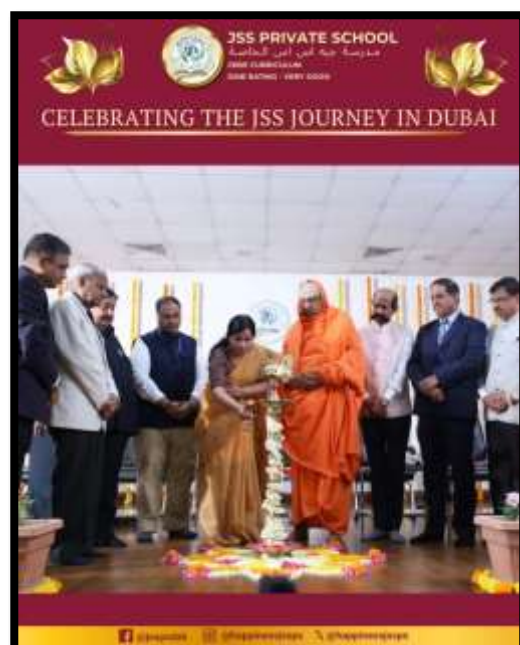

Some of the major achievements and activities are as below:

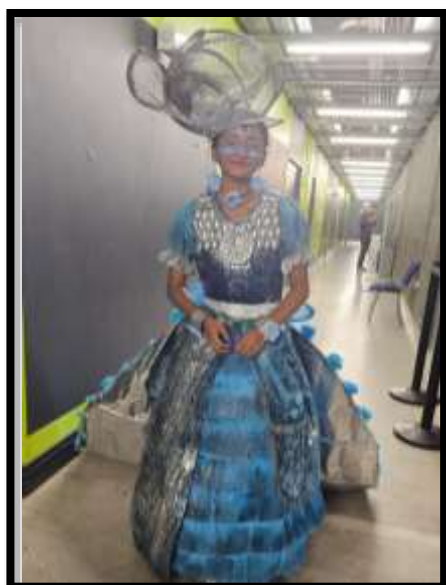

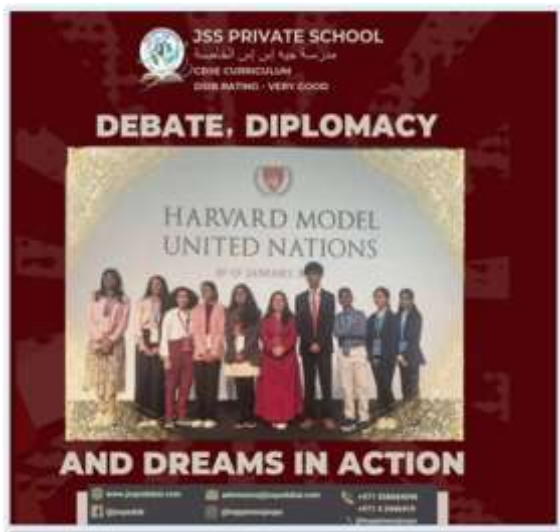

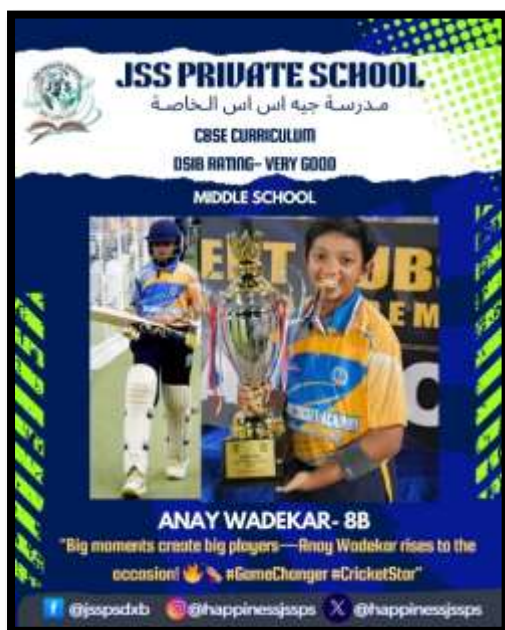
