3. Do ensure that your ward does not carry his/her mobile phone or other electronic devices
4. Parents of **Grades 1 to 3** are requested to pick up their child from school on Friday 23rd January 2026 by 9.30 pm. **School transport will not be available for students on Friday night.**
5. Parents of **Grades 4 to 8** are requested to pick up their child from school on **Saturday, 24th January 2026 by 8.30 am. School transport will not be available for students on Saturday morning.**
6. There will be sufficient number of teachers, medical staff and bus monitors to ensure that the students are safe and secure in the school apart from extra security arrangements for the event.
7. All food will strictly be vegetarian. In case your child needs to opt for Jain Food, please mention the same on the acknowledgement slip attached below.
8. If your child is interested in being a part of this experience, please fill up the registration form and hand it over to your child's class teacher along with the fee latest by **Monday 12th January 2026.** Your support in timely registration will help in the efficient planning of our NUTS 2026
