


**Soaring Eagles Takes the Crown!**



Rishi's perseverance and brilliance set a benchmark for academic excellence.







A big round of applause to all our winners for making us proud and showcasing exceptional talent in **logical reasoning and critical thinking**. They truly shone and set an inspiring example for others



We are super proud to share that **Vaibhav** has won the **Sparkling Award** in the **Junior Category of Mathello Quest 2025**.





## Sports Achievements




Her dedication, speed, and confidence in the pool truly make us proud. Congratulations to our young swimming star, and we wish her many more victories ahead.




