



**Subject: CBSE Class X Assessment Scheme (Middle East Regions) - Important Update on Result Declaration for Class X.**

**Subject:**

Dear Students and Parents,

Following the CBSE notification (Ref: CBSE/CE/SPPS/2026/2), we would like to provide clarification regarding the evaluation process for the Class X main examination results. As you are aware, the exams conducted from February 17 to February 28, 2026, were completed as scheduled, while the remaining examinations were cancelled due to regional circumstances.

**Subject: Assessment scheme for declaration of results of Class X in Middle East Regions - reg**

The CBSE has cancelled the examinations of Class X main examination vide its circular dated 05.03.2026 after a critical review of the prevailing situation in parts of the Middle East (Bahrain, Iran, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the UAE). It was informed that the mode of declaration of results for Class X candidates in the Middle East will be notified separately in due course.

Examinations scheduled from 17.02.2026 to 28.02.2026 were conducted successfully. During this period, the following examinations were completed:-

**Based on the conduct of examinations, there are following cases:-**

1. Students appeared in all examinations
2. Students appeared in 4 examinations
3. Students appeared in 3 examinations
4. Students appeared in 2 examinations
5. Private students registered under compartment category

**Accordingly, the results shall be prepared based on the following Assessment Scheme:-**

- (a). **Students appeared in all examinations:-** The result of such students will be declared based on their performance in the examinations.
- (b). **Students appeared in 4 examinations:-** The result of such students will be declared based on the average of the marks obtained in best three performing subjects for the subjects whose examinations have not been conducted.
- (c). **Students appeared in 3 examinations:-** The result of such students will be declared based on the average of the marks obtained in best two performing subjects for the subjects whose examinations have not been conducted.
- (d). **Students appeared in 2 examinations:-** There are very few students who have appeared in the examinations in only 2 subjects. Their results will be declared based on the average of the marks of two subjects in the remaining subjects.

- (e). **Students of 2025 or earlier registered only upto 2 subjects:-**
  - (i). If these students have appeared in O1 or O2 of their registered examinations, their result will be declared based on their performance.
  - (ii). If any examination is left for these students, an opportunity will be given to them to appear in the second Board examinations.
- (f). Students from these countries who have changed their examination centre to some other country, their result will be declared based on their performance in the examinations.
- (g). Result of Middle East students will be declared alongwith rest of the students.
- (h). Students will be allowed to improve their performance in second Board examinations as per policy.
- (i). At the time of preparation of results if any other suitable action is required to be taken, the same will be decided and taken by the Board.
- (j). Internal assessment is a year-long exercise and it has already been completed, hence, the same will be taken as uploaded by the schools.
- (k). Result prepared using assessment scheme will be final. No special examination will be conducted in any circumstances except the examinations conducted by CBSE as per its declared policy.
- (l). Decision of the Competent Authority of the Board shall be final.
- (m). Class XII assessment scheme will be communicated separately once decided.

### How Your Results Will Be Calculated

The Board has established a formula based on the number of examinations a student was able to complete before the cancellation:

- **Appeared in all exams:** Results will be declared based on your actual performance in those examinations.
- **Appeared in 4 exams:** For the remaining subjects, marks will be awarded based on the **average of your best three** performing subjects.
- **Appeared in 3 exams:** For the remaining subjects, marks will be awarded based on the **average of your best two** performing subjects.
- **Appeared in 2 exams:** For the remaining subjects, marks will be awarded based on the **average of those two** subjects.

### Key Highlights for Your Attention

- **Internal Assessment:** All internal assessment marks already uploaded by the school will be used as it is, as this was a year-long exercise.
- **Results Timeline:** Our results will be declared along with the rest of the CBSE students globally.
- **Second Board Examinations:** Students will have the opportunity to improve their performance in the second Board examinations as per the existing policy.
- **Finality of Results:** The results prepared using this assessment scheme will be considered final; no "special" examinations will be conducted outside of the Board's declared policy. Decision of the Competent Authority of the Board shall be final.

### A Note for Class XII

Please note that this assessment scheme applies **only to Class X**. The scheme for Class XII is currently being decided and will be communicated separately by the Board.

We understand this has been a period of uncertainty. Please rest assured that the Board's decision is designed to ensure fairness for all students in the region.
